The Refugee Employability Programme (REP) will help you build on the skills you need to find fulfilling work and look after yourself and your family.

When you join the REP, you will get your own case manager who will support you through the process of finding work. They will also show you how to access local services like community groups, healthcare and childcare.

Individual case manager support

Your case manager will listen to you so they can understand what kind of career you want to have. They will give you a personal development plan that will be tailored to your ambitions and personal circumstances, and they will meet with you regularly.

learning English – language classes and conversation clubs to help you integrate into society and interact more easily with everyday services like doctors and schools



employability skills – CV writing and interview practice so you can find meaningful work and build a life in the United Kingdom



integrating into British life – learning about British culture so you can be a part of your community and society

Joining the REP will provide you with the support you need to expand your existing skills so you can find fulfilling work and live a happy life in the United Kingdom.
